TEMPO Milwaukee Foundation Announces \$15,000 Continuing Education Grant for Professional Women

Now accepting applications through March 2, 2018

MILWAUKEE (January 16, 2018) – The TEMPO Milwaukee Foundation, the 501(c)3 charitable arm of TEMPO Milwaukee, is now accepting applications for the first-ever Continuing Education Grant. Up to \$15,000 will be awarded to one or multiple female professionals who are seeking continuing education opportunities such as a certificate that will enhance skills, attending a specialized conference, or a leadership program.

“The Continuing Education Grant is a significant enhancement to the TEMPO Milwaukee Foundation, made possible through generous support from the community over the years,” said Jennifer Dirks, President and CEO of TEMPO Milwaukee. “We are fortunate to be able to offer local women the opportunity to enhance their leadership skills by taking courses or attending programs that otherwise would not be financially feasible.”

The purpose of the grant is to encourage leadership development and recognize women who are having or will have an impact in the community. Eligible applicants are women with at least six years of professional experience who reside in the greater Milwaukee area. Non-members of TEMPO Milwaukee who meet the application criteria are encouraged to apply. The grant cannot be used to obtain a higher education degree such as a Master’s degree or to cover membership dues.

“TEMPO Milwaukee’s mission is to further the impact of women leaders, and we’re grateful to have this new avenue to help deserving professional women in Milwaukee accelerate their careers,” said Jody Lowe, President/Managing Director of The Lowe Group, and board member for both TEMPO Milwaukee and the TEMPO Milwaukee Foundation.
