#### **KEYNOTE/FEATURED SPEAKER:**

THE POWER OF A DIAGNOSIS, GERRY HOWZE

In early 2020 at the age of 53, Gerry Howze's outlook on life – both personal and professional – was at an all-time high. Serving as Executive Director of PEARLS for Teen Girls, the organization experienced its largest growth; expansion; the number of girls it serves and its largest profit in its 27-year history. Gerry was honored as a 2020 Betty Award Winner and recognized as the "Standout Sister" by *Milwaukee Magazine*. She had built a squad of fierce female advocates around her. Life was good. Until it wasn't.

In August 2021, Gerry would hear news that would turn her world upside down and inside out. In this intimate keynote address, Gerry will share her story with TEMPO's Emerging Women Leaders and guests, and most importantly talk about how it has impacted her as a leader. She will discuss how she, despite this devastating setback, managed to remain optimistic, grounded and harnessed her superpowers! Gerry will provide her lessons in leadership and how attendees can learn to face their fears, challenges and incredible obstacles, head on.

#### **ABOUT GERRY:**

As Executive Director of PEARLS for Teen Girls, Gerry Howze has a vision that includes serving thousands of girls and building an entire movement of young women prepared to lead Milwaukee, our nation and the world into a vibrant new future. Her inspiration for PEARLS has grown from years of experience-as PEARLS first Program Coordinator, and first Director of Program Services; she has her pulse on the needs of PEARLS and overall trends impacting girls in Milwaukee, and urban & rural girls.

Prior to PEARLS, Howze has developed her wealth of programming knowledge through her work as Club Manager at the Hillside Boys & Girls Club, Director of Goldin, COA Youth & Family Center, a nationally certified trainer of the Nurturing Program, and KIDS FIRST Coalition Coordinator at Aurora Family Service. Howze has a B.A. in Human Services from Springfield College, is a 2005 Future Milwaukee graduate and has earned certificates in youth development, training and leadership from the Youth Work Learning Center, Family Development Resources, Aurora Health Care, Leadership Intensive and Transformational Leadership Quest Development Shop.

Gerry is an involved community member and is a current Board member for TEMPO Milwaukee where she serves as the Vice Chair for TEMPO's Emerging Women Leaders and sits on TEMPO's Diversity and Inclusion Committee. She has also attended Harvard Business School for Strategic Perspectives in Nonprofit Management and Georgetown University's Global Social Enterprise Initiative – New Strategies Program. In February 2020, she received a Milwaukee Times Black Excellence Award and was recognized as a "Standout Sister" in Milwaukee Magazine's Betty Awards in December 2020.
