Founded in 1975, TEMPO Milwaukee is a professional networking organization for Milwaukee businesswomen in senior leadership, C-Suite and executive-level roles. The typical TEMPO Milwaukee member is a senior leader within her company/organization with at least five years of experience in a senior-level role. Members are highly active in the community, serving in leadership roles on boards, committees, etc. TEMPO Milwaukee's 330+ members join the organization for leadership, networking and mentoring opportunities among their peer group - women who have reached or will soon reach the pinnacle of their careers.

CRITERIA:

- 10+ years of professional experience.
- 5+ years of senior/executive-level or high managerial experience.
- One of her organization's top executives or has direct working involvement with top executives.
- Demonstrates commitment to the community through involvement and leadership in professional and/or civic organizations.
- Strong nomination from a current TEMPO Milwaukee member who is familiar with the membership criteria.



EMERGING WOMEN LEADERS

TEMPO Milwaukee's Emerging Women Leaders (EWL) initiative was founded in 2015. EWL represents the next generation of Milwaukee's female leaders – with participants aspiring to be TEMPO Milwaukee members once they meet the criteria. The typical Emerging Women Leaders participant is recognized within her company as a leader and high performer. She can identify a minimum of one volunteer commitment in which she's actively involved. Emerging Women Leaders join for professional development, mentoring, community involvement and networking opportunities with their peer group, as well as with TEMPO Milwaukee members at select events.

CRITERIA:

- 6+ years of professional experience (mid-career, not entry level). Executive-level/managerial experience is a plus.
- Demonstrates commitment to the community through involvement and leadership in professional and/or civic organizations.
- Displays leadership within her company/organization; supervisor support/corporate recognition and support is encouraged.
- Strong nomination from a current TEMPO Milwaukee member or Emerging Women Leader who is familiar with the program.
